

# Ways to pay

Knox Makers' preferred method of payment is through QuickBooks. This minimizes bank fees and automatically updates your account, reducing administrative burden.

QuickBooks offers several ways to pay: credit and debit cards, direct deposit (ACH), Apple Pay, Venmo and PayPal. You can make one-time or recurring payments on a day-of-the-month that works best for you.

If you prefer, you can still pay by check. Leave the hand-written kind in the blue metal box mounted to the wall at the front of Bay 2. Or you can have your bank send your checks to:
